## FCE

The FCE Certification course was created for Health Care Professionals who wish to become Certified FCE Evaluators and learn how to use human performance measurement tools to perform Functional Capacity Evaluations. Training will include ARCON, FACTS, VERNOVA computerized systems and manual measurement instruments.

Training will include hands on instruction on how to use the measurement instruments, how to document clinical observations. Instruction on interpretation and report writing will be included in this course.

The hands on section will include:

Intake Interview, Questionnaires, Range of Motion, Grip & Pinch Strength, Manual Muscle Testing, Static & Dynamic Lifting, Dexterity tests, Posture tests, Tolerance tests and Job Simulation activities.

## Workplace and Homesite Assessment

The Workplace and Homesite Assessment training courses were created for Health Care Professionals. These courses have been designed to prepare health care professionals to perform the assessments and write reports. They have been tailored for people working with Motor Vehicle Accident claims. A detailed "how to" section will include a "hands on" portion. An overview of how the insurance initiated and the health care provider initiated assessments function within the current Statutory Accident Benefit Schedule (SABS) will be provided.

- What acceptable standards are, and why.

## The Assessment Industry

This course has been designed to prepare Health Care Professionals to understand the Statutory Accident Benefit Schedule (SABS). The SABS is complex and navigation requires understanding of the many sections and subsections. An overview of the SABS highlighting the most pertinent sections and commonly used forms will be provided.

An overview of how the insurance initiated and the health care provider initiated assessments function is included.

To provide a real world day to day understanding of how Health Care Professionals interact with the SABS, the afternoon session will include two question and answer style presentations. The first with Health Care Professional currently providing insurance initiated assessments follow by a Health Care Professional providing health care provider initiated treatment and assessments.
