FCE

The FCE Certification lecture was created for Health Care Professionals who wish to become Certified FCE Evaluators and learn how to use human performance measurement tools to perform Functional Capacity Evaluations. Training will include use of computerized systems and manual measurement instruments.

Training will include hands on instruction on how to use the measurement instruments, how to document clinical observations. Instruction on interpretation and report writing will be included in this course.

The hands on section will include:

Intake Interview, Questionnaires, Range of Motion, Grip & Pinch Strength, Manual Muscle Testing, Static & Dynamic Lifting, Dexterity tests, Posture tests, Tolerance tests and Job Simulation activities.
